5. At Junior Camp, participants will only be shooting at Targets and not at participants

GOGGLES ARE NEVER TO BE REMOVED FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER ON THE FIRING RANGE

6. Paint markers are NOT allowed in the safety areas.
7. The participants are NOT allowed to push or mess with each other whilst on the firing range.
8. Do NOT shoot your marker at anyone involved in the game.
9. Do NOT fire your gun once you leave the game field.
10. Do NOT leave the game fields during play. Stay within the defined boundaries.
11. Do NOT aim at the head or face.
12. Do NOT shoot at any visible wild animals.
13. Please respect the equipment, grounds and others.

Mobile Phone Use at Camp This Year

At Junior Camp 2025 we are implementing a policy of limited mobile/ no mobile telephones in Junior Camp.

Children will be allowed to bring their mobile phones to camp but will be required to hand them in to leaders for most of the day and especially at key times during the day. During services, activities swimming sessions and throughout the night time period. Mobile phones will not be allowed in bedrooms at any time. Leaders will ensure children have their phones in order to contact their parents at reasonable times during the day. Your church leader/pastor will organise who keeps your child's mobile telephone. We suggest that you agree with your Pastor/Church leaders when would be best to contact them to enquire of your child's well being during the camp week.
